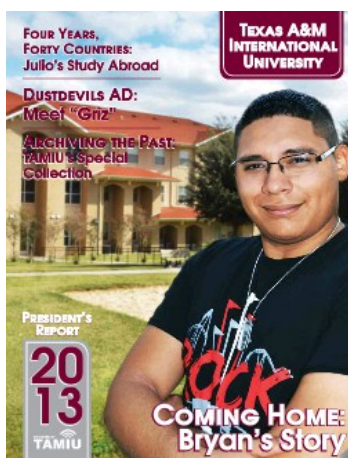

Kendra Rodríguez '09

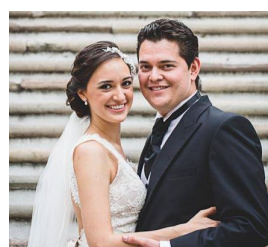

received assistance from the Office with her resume, interviewing skills, internship/job search, and employment referral and placement.



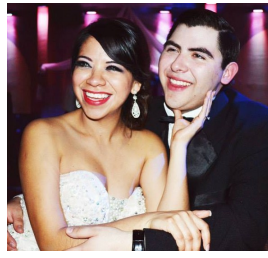
Sharim Garza '11
