Antonio Casarez '09,'11, had the opportunity to participate in the Texas Global Exchange Program, and visited Baku, Azerbaijan and Istanbul, Turkey. The program promotes international affairs and relations with Texas. Since Baku, Azerbaijan is an oil-booming country, the networking and similarities with Texas are beneficial for both Azerbaijan and Texas.

"The rich experience of traveling to Azerbaijan and learning is more than a fulfilled journey," said Casarez, "The educational business meetings at the Azerbaijan Diplomatic Academy informed us about the historical, political, economic, and social development of the country."

He then traveled to Istanbul, Turkey where he met with Turkish CEO's, business leaders, and international advocates. "Turkey was also enriching through not only the business meetings, but the historical visits to the Bosphorus, the Hagia Sophia, the Blue Mosque, the Grand and Spice Bazaars," said Casarez, "The food was quite delicious as well.
