BYLAW SPOTLIGHT:

14.3.2.1 Participation Before Certification—Recruited and Nonrecruited Student-Athlete. If a recruited or nonrecruited student-athlete reports for athletics participation before the high school core-curriculum grade-point average and test score have been certified, the student-athlete may practice, but not compete, for a maximum of 45 days, provided the student-athlete is enrolled full time or has been accepted for enrollment as a regular full-time student. After this 45-day period, the student shall have established minimum requirements as a qualifier (as certified by the NCAA Eligibility Center) to continue practicing or to compete, or the minimum requirements as a partial qualifier to continue practicing.

NOTE: The last day of the 45 days is Thursday, October 10th.

Interps of Interest

Participation of Ineligible Student-Athletes in Activities Related to Away-From-Home Contests (II):

The Division II Legislation Committee determined that a student-athlete who is not eligible for competition (e.g., transfer serving an academic year in residence, student-athlete not meeting progress-toward-degree requirements, partial qualifier) may not receive expenses for or participate in practice sessions associated with an away-from-home competition even if the student-athlete pays his or her own expenses to travel to the site of the away-from-home competition.

Participation of Partial Qualifiers and Nonqualifiers in Entertainment Activities (II)

The Division II Legislation Committee determined that a partial qualifier may participate in entertainment activities on campus or in the locale of the institution during the first year of enrollment. A nonqualifier may not participate in entertainment at any location during the first year of enrollment.
