ATHLETIC COMPLIANCE REMINDERS

- Prospective student-athletes that have committed for 20-21 academic year. Coaches please make sure to add them under the recruiting tab on Compliance Assistant (CAI).
- Coaches please make sure to update periodically your Institutional Request List (IRL) on the Eligibility Center (EC).
- To assist you with monitoring your PSA's, tracking student(s) can be enabled at the bottom of your IRL.
 - as well as deactivating, un-tracking, flagging or un-flagging student(s) as a transfer.
- Head coaches must submit "Squad list change form" on ARMS as soon as a student-athlete has been dismissed, quit, exhausted eligibility, or graduated.

SPORTS WAGERING

10.02.1 Sports Wagering. Sports wagering includes placing, accepting or soliciting a wager (on a staff member's or student-athlete's own behalf or on the behalf of others) of any type with any individual or organization on any intercollegiate, amateur or professional team or contest. Examples of sports wagering include, but are not limited to, the use of a bookmaker or parlay card; Internet sports wagering; auctions in which bids are placed on teams, individuals or contests; and pools or fantasy leagues in which an entry fee is required and there is an opportunity to win a prize.

10.02.2 Wager. A wager is any agreement in which an individual or entity agrees to give up an item of value (e.g., cash, shirt, dinner) in exchange for the possibility of gaining another item of value.

10.3 Sports Wagering Activities. The following individuals shall not knowingly participate in sports wagering activities or provide information to individuals involved in or associated with any type of sports wagering activities concerning intercollegiate, amateur or professional athletics competition: (Adopted: 1/8/07 effective 8/1/07)

(a) Staff members of an institution's athletics department;

(b) Non-athletics department staff members who have responsibilities within or over the athletics department (e.g., chancellor or president, faculty athletics representative, individual to whom athletics reports);

- (c) Staff members of a conference office; and
- (d) Student-athletes.
