Dr. Snyder is a native of Laredo, Texas and is proud to have attended United Day School before graduating from Alexander High School in 2001. She went on to earn her bachelor's degree in Biology from Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore, Maryland followed by her medical degree from the University of Texas Southwestern in Dallas, TX. She then moved to Cleveland, Ohio to complete her residency in Internal Medicine and two fellowships in Nephrology and Transplant Nephrology from the world-renowned Cleveland Clinic.

Dr. Snyder moved back to Laredo six years ago and is now a practicing nephrologist at the Hope Kidney Clinic. She cares for patients at both local hospitals and is especially interested in Transplant Nephrology. Training the next generation of doctors is also something she cares deeply about, and she is a faculty member for the University of Incarnate Word-LMC Internal Medicine Residency Program. This year, she was appointed medical director of the University of Texas Health Science Center's first transplant outreach clinic here in Laredo, TX. And starting January 2023, she is the new Chief of Staff for Laredo Medical Center, making her the first woman in Laredo Medical Center history to assume the role as Chief of Staff.
