- Ms. Malagon Medina has been a Customs Broker since 1994. She is also a founding member of "Grupo Fernández Malagón, Agencia Aduanal", which has been present in the main customs ports of Mexico for over 30 years.
- She has a Law Degree, with a specialty in Labor Law, from the Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México.
- She has a Master's Degree in Senior Management in Logistics and Customs from the Instituto Universitario CAAAREM.
- She was the first woman to preside over the Asociación de Agentes Aduanales de Nuevo Laredo in the 84 years of its existence.
- She has given conferences related to foreign trade and logistics in higher education institutions such as the Universidad de Monterrey, the Universidad de Chapingo, and the Universidad Autónoma de Tamaulipas.
- She is a faithful promoter of new generations, motivating them to achieve their objectives, goals, and results as a product of discipline, teamwork, adaptation to change, stress management and problem solving.
- In 2007, she became the first woman in Mexico to receive the Authorized Economic Operator certification, granted by the Tax Administration System of Mexico.
- Her leadership in the customs sector has led her to expose and defend issues such regarding infrastructure and professional services of international trade in the Laredo Region and in international and national forums.
