#### I. Squad Tryout Information

The TAMIU CHEER SQUAD members will lead cheers at men's & women's home volleyball games, soccer games, and basketball games. The squad will also travel to some out of town basketball tournaments and make numerous appearances on television and radio and at non-University functions as determined by the Head Coach.

#### **Tryout Information Requirement**

A professional NCA cheer choreographer will host a two-day tryout session to assess the skills, abilities and potential of interested and qualified candidates for the cheer squad positions.

1<sup>st</sup> session: June 7 & 8<sup>th</sup> of 2012

Official Tryout Day: June 9, 2012

2<sup>nd</sup> Session: July 19 & 20<sup>th</sup> of 2012

Official Tryout Day: July 21, 2012

After candidates have been selected cheer training camp will be held Saturday, July 28 and Sunday, July, 29th of 2012.

#### II. Member Selection Process

A professional NCA cheer choreographer will host a two-day tryout session to assess the abilities, leadership skills and potential of interested and qualified candidates for one of the predetermined number of available positions.

Tryouts are intended to be a low stress event. For that reason, candidates will tryout in a group of three and perform jump sequence, fight song, cheer, and short dance in front of a panel of judges. Each candidate is required to have an entrance of either a tumbling pass or jump and spirit in pass. A short interview with the candidate may be conducted at anytime during Thursday's and Friday's tryout practice sessions.

#### Notification of Selection

The persons selected for the TAMIU CHEER SQUAD will be called to notify them that they made the squad and will receive a confirmation email through their student email (name@dusty.tamiu.edu)

#### Minimum Qualifications for Tryouts

Persons who wish to tryout for the TAMIU CHEER SQUAD must meet the following minimum qualifications:

(Please note that incoming freshman and transfer students, DO NOT have to be regularly admitted in order to attend a schedule tryout session, although all individuals selected to the spirit program WILL NOT be guaranteed admissions into the university.)

- 1. Must be a TAMIU student in Good Standing
- 2. If a current TAMIU student, not be on disciplinary probation.
- 3. Have sufficient physical fitness, strength, and athletic skills to perform the cheerleader activities described below.

- 4. Have health/hospitalization insurance in an amount comparable to the minimum coverage offered through the University's student insurance program. - 5. Have completed the tryout packet as describe below in the tryout packet section.

#### Selection Criteria

A panel of judges will select members for the TAMIU Cheer Squad. Members will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- Strong leadership qualities
- Charismatic presence/personality
- Confidence
- Independence
- Enthusiasm
- Athletic/Cheerleading Ability

#### Academic Requirements:

- Full-Time Student(12hrs) at Texas A&M International University
- Maintain a GPA of at least a 2.5
