



# Dusty's Junior U Summer Camp

## STUDENT AND PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

The Continuing Education staff of Dusty's Junior U Camp is committed to providing a safe and enjoyable experience for your child; however, students are also responsible to assist in these efforts. Parents are responsible to make sure their child understands the guidelines below. Each student must read and sign the Code of Conduct Contract before coming to camp so they know what is expected of them.

Students must inform staff if they are experiencing a problem with another camper or other issues. If we are not informed about a problem, we cannot stop the problem or assist the student.

- Students are responsible for ALL their belongings at ALL times. Continuing Education (CE) and camp personnel are not responsible for lost or stolen items (including electronics). It is at the risk of the camper when bringing items to camp. Students are NOT allowed to bring money to camp. If they did not bring lunch, parents will be called to bring lunch.
- Students are expected to follow ALL rules and directions given by teachers and aides at ALL times. Any inappropriate behavior will be handled by the Office of Continuing Education. Parents will be called to pick up their children depending on severity of behavior.
- Students will participate in all aspects of the camp and follow their daily camp schedule.
- Students will show respect towards other campers, teachers, aides, volunteers, and any CE staff. They are expected to follow instructions from ALL camp staff. Students must be kind, courteous, and respectful to everyone, including staff, at camp. Students will respect the personal space and property of others.
- Students will assume personal responsibility for any camp/TAMIU equipment they use. Students will never mark, deface or destroy camp/TAMIU or personal property.
- Acts of violence will not be tolerated and students will refrain from deliberately causing bodily harm to campers or staff. I understand that pushing, kicking, hitting, biting, or fighting are not acceptable behavior and will not be tolerated and will be grounds for suspension/dismissal from the camp. Firearms and weapons, including knives, are prohibited at Dusty's Junior U CE Camp.
- Students' use of inappropriate language, conduct, or harassment is prohibited at camp. Students will be respectful, cooperative and will contribute positively to the experience of fellow campers. Students will keep their hands to themselves at all times. We expect all campers to have FUN at camp, but not at the expense of others. Bullying is not tolerated at Dusty's Junior U camp and can result in suspension/dismissal from camp.
- There will be no refunds for any verbal or physical behavior or misconduct that results in a suspension or removal from camp.
- No class changes will be accepted during the camp all class schedules are final. Parents will be given notice for deadline of class changes.

By signing this agreement I understand that if I disobey the instructions of Dusty's Junior U staff, the Camp Director will be notified of my inappropriate conduct. I may be asked to call my parents/guardians and report my conduct not in compliance with these guidelines. Violation of the CODE OF CONDUCT can be grounds for automatic dismissal. I understand that refunds are NOT given when a camper is dismissed from the program.
