### How to become a Fitness Professional Through the BS in Kinesiology (Non-Certification) Degree

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#### Job Outlook:

Employment of fitness trainers and instructors is projected to grow 10 percent from 2016 to 2026, faster than the average for all occupations. As businesses, government, and insurance organizations continue to recognize the benefits of health and fitness programs for their employees, incentives to join gyms or other types of health clubs are expected to increase the need for fitness trainers and instructors.

#### Pay:

The median annual wage for fitness trainers and instructors was \$38,160 in May 2016.

## What Can I Do With This Degree?

After completion of the Kinesiology on the non-certification track, students can begin careers in cardiac rehabilitation and corporate fitness settings.

The degree will also prepare the student for graduate studies in exercise science, occupational therapy and other allied health fields.
