# How to become a School Administrator through the Master of Science in Educational Administration Program

## What Do Educational Administrators Do?

Educational Administratiors plan, direct, and coordinate the adacemic, administrativee, or auxilary activities of public or private elementary or secondary level schools. Principals in particular coordinate curriculums, oversee teachers and other school staff, and provide a safe and productive learning environment for students.

#### **Certifications:**

- Candidates will be eligible to complete their certification exam in the final semester of their specalization courses (typically semester 5 of the program).
- Eligibility would be dependent on the candidate's successful completion of all preliminary activities in the certification plan.

### Job Outlook

- Typically, principals at UISD have been with the district for an average of 20 years.
- Typically, principals at LISD have been with the district for an average of 19 years.
