Procedure Statement and Reason for Procedure

This SAP regulates the fire and life safety inspections conducted for each building at Texas A&M International University (TAMIU).

Procedures and Responsibilities

1. RESPONSIBLITIES

- 1.1 The Office of Environmental Health and Safety (EH&S) shall inspect each campus and residential building at least <u>once per fiscal year</u>.
- 1.2 EH&S shall maintain all documentation of any fire and life safety inspections and assessments consistent with the Texas A&M University System Records Retention Schedule.

MAIN CAMPUS

- 2.1 An inspection report will be presented to the Director of EH&S and made available to other pertinent personnel such as, but not limited to, vice presidents, deans, directors, and chairs if needed.
- 2.2 Deficiencies determined to be a serious safety hazard by EH&S shall be corrected as soon as practicable.

- 2.3 A follow-up inspection will be conducted within 45 working days from the submission date on the inspection report.
- 2.4 A follow-up report shall be presented to the Director of EH&S and, if required, forwarded to pertinent personnel such as, but not limited to, vice presidents, deans, directors, and chairs for review and appropriate action.

RESIDENTIAL HALLS

- 3.1 Inspections will be conducted with the assistance of residential staff.
- 3.2 An inspection report of deficiencies will be sent to the Director of Housing and Residence Life for correction.
- 3.3 Deficiencies determined to be a serious safety hazard by EH&S shall be corrected as soon as practicable.
- 3.4 A follow-up inspection of the deficiencies will be conducted by EH&S within 45 working days from the submission date on the inspection report.
- 3.5 A follow-up report of deficiencies shall be forwarded to the Director of Housing and Residence Life.
