If the student is exhibiting behaviors which suggest he or she might harm him or herself or anyone else, or you feel threatened

## Call 956-326-2911 or 911 immediately

If the student <u>needs support</u> but is <u>not</u> exhibiting behaviors that suggest self-or otherdirected harm, and you <u>do not</u> feel threatened



Ask what the student needs, contact or refer the student to the following resources (consult the table below), if they consent.
