

Faculty Ownership of Online Course Evaluation Process:

The evaluation window for the online course evaluations this semester will be open from Monday, November 17th to Tuesday, November 25th. In order to enhance student participation in online course evaluations, the final exam folder will not be visible to students until they provide evidence that they have submitted their course evaluation.

A folder named "STEP 1: Complete Evaluation" has been added inside your lessons tab on ANGEL. In this folder, we have created a dropbox titled "STEP 2: Course Evaluation Proof Dropbox". As soon as the student submits a completion receipt, the "Final Exam" folder will be visible to students.

In order for the Final Exam documents to be visible, you will need to make sure the following takes place:

1. Upload your final exam document(s) inside the "Final Exam" folder. DO NOT rename the folder or change the folder settings.
2. If a student missed the course evaluation window or did not submit proof of their evaluation completion, you will be able to add their names in the "Final Exam" team.

To manually add students to the "Final Exam Team" follow these steps"

1. Click on the Manage Tab



2. Click on the Teams Link



3. Locate the Final Exam team and click on the "add users link"



4. Select the student and click on "add selected" to complete the process.

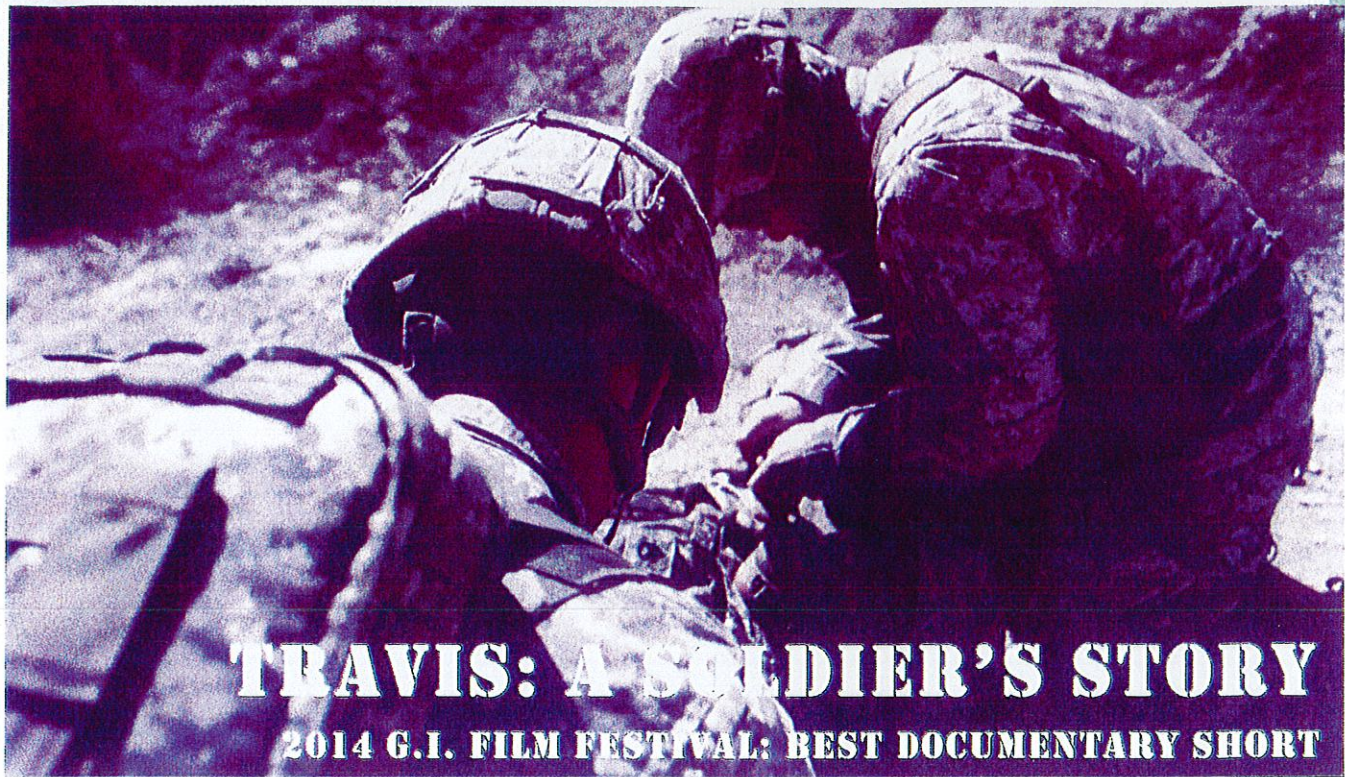
