## **GUIDELINES FOR POSTERS & VIDEOS**

Posters in PowerPoint format and videos are accepted. Please be sure to include the following information:

- Name of course and of all participants (students, faculty, community partners)
- Description of your service experience:
  - o What did you do?
  - o When did you do it?
  - o Who did you serve?
- Examine connection of service to course content:
  - o How was service related to course content?
  - o How did your service help the community?
  - o How did this help your personal growth?
- Articulate learning by examining your experience:
  - o What did I learn?
  - o How did I learn it?
  - o Why does this learning matter?
  - o What will I do in light of this learning?
- Pictures or visual images of the service project.
- For the oral presentation be ready to answer the following questions:
  - What have you learned by being involved in this program/project?
  - How do you plan on utilizing the skills you have learned beyond this course?
  - What has been your biggest challenge?
  - What has been the most exciting experience with this program?

Please proofread for grammar and spelling, use light background colors for optimum quality.

Posters can be printed in a professional format by the Service-Learning Center. If you would like your poster to be printed, submit your poster in PPP format (48" width by 36" height) by e-mail to servicelearning@tamiu.edu by Friday, October 30.

You will need to explain what your service-learning project was about and what you learned form this experience.
