Students must have a minimum **GPA of a 2.0**.

If transferring with less than 24 credit hours, submit official high school transcript and official SAT/ACT scores.

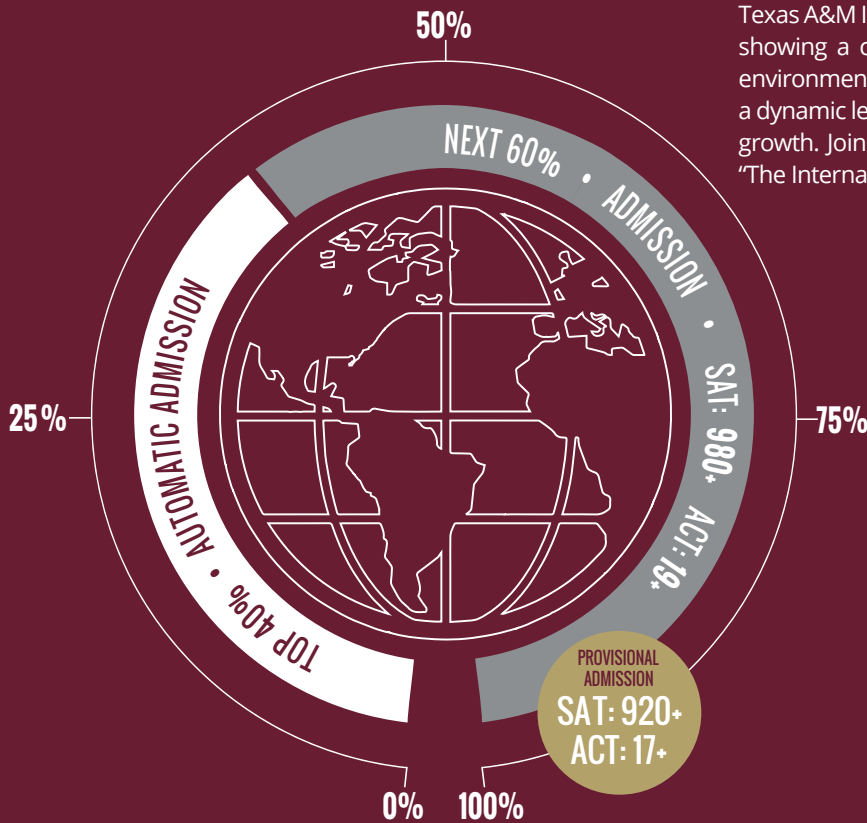
