CLASS DISTRIBUTION RULES

SECTION NUMBERING SCHEME

1st character indicates semester/term:

Fall = 1 Spring = 2 Flex I 7-wk = 6 Flex II 7-wk = 7

2nd character indicates time/type of class:

0 = Before 5pm C = Clinical

6 = After 5pm H = Hybrid

7 = Weekend L = Laboratory

8 = Distance Ed M = Applied/Ensemble Music

9 = Independent Study

3rd character indicates class day:

MWF – odd numbers (e.g. 101, 103)

TR – even numbers (e.g. 102, 104)

Study Abroad classes will be assigned section number 900.
