I. Welcome

III. Treasurer's report: \$3,736.83

IV. Speaker/Presentation:

- Mike Munoa, Office of Information Technology Microsoft Teams Rollout
 - Microsoft Teams is replacing Spark instant messaging.
 - In the next 6-12 months there will be additional support, features, and functions for MS Teams.
 - As of July, the UNIV will be going 100% for instant messaging with MS Teams.
 - o OIT has been training on MS Teams and are prepared to assist UNIV when needed.
 - Formal support for Web conferencing for Teams is also available and has similar functionality to Webex.
 - Over the next three months OIT is going through a process of internal testing of MS Teams as a means to provide technical support for the UNIV.
 - OIT is working on the trial process of MS Teams.
 - Collaboration channel groups for MS Teams is the final piece to work on for projects together.
 - Within and inter-department groups can be formed when focused on a project and can have access to a central repository of files. Everyone will be able to see what everyone is working on. OIT is working on the structure of this feature.
 - All of the new features are in a pilot testing process to slowly phase in thereafter.

- One Drive is a cloud based file storage that provides a level of back up of files and is available for employee use.
- o At the end of the calendar year, Syncplicity will be retired and migrated into One Drive.
- OIT will provide information on how to migrate files.
- MS Forms is another component of Office 365 that OIT is still working on and creating guides to gradually provide support for.
- Webex will eventually be phased out by next year, but will remain available as an option for video conferencing in the meantime.
- The retention policy for MS teams is 48-hours. Any messages after 48-hours old will be wiped out. There is a UNIV policy on retention of documents and emails. The policy for instant messaging is two days. Spark did not have the capability to wipe out messaging.
- o Retention may be different for every phase of the Teams rollout.
 - For example, Teams has the capability to record meetings, but that function may not be immediately available. However, in MS Collaboration, messaging might fall under a different retention requirement because it may not fit within the policy of instant messaging.
 - OIT is looking at the various system and administrative retention policies as the different phases of MS teams is launched and supported.

- o June 30th is the two-step process deadline and there are currently no extensions.
- Access https://tamus/myevive.com enter your UIN and information from your BCBSTX insurance card. Note: (Both employee and covered spouse will use the employee's UIN to register.)
- o Provide your information following the instructions on the registration pages.
- Also accessible from your TAMUS single sign-on account in workday http://sso.tamus.edu
 (employees only).
- Complete two wellness activities on My Evive between September 1st and June 30th.
- Applies to all employees and covered spouses enrolled in the A&M Care Plan (each has to complete two items on their own personalized checklist by the deadline).
- You can verify your completion status for the wellness premium incentive one of two ways:
 - Logging in to TAMUS single sign-on account in workday at http://sso.tamus.edu and click on TAMUS two-step logo.
 - Logging in to your My Evive account at https://tamus.myevive.com
 - This process may take 60-90 days to credit from BCBS. **TAMIU HR employees are unable to view employee list of activities.
 - Contact My Evive member services if you believe you have completed the two-step incentive but the information is not reflected in your My Evive account.
- Additional physicians are also available through MD Life. This can be helpful for employees
 when in need of an alternate physician when out of town, during evening hours, or when the
 PCP is not readily available.
