Staff Senate News

- Response to Suggestion Box Inquiry
 - Parking Lot Improvements: Question regarding what upgrades were done to the parking lots. Cihtlalli detailed a response from Mr. Castillo, AVP Finance & Administration, "Large cracks were addressed during the period. You should be able to see the epoxy in the cracks that were filled. Parking lot striping along with fire lane curb painting will be forthcoming. Some painting will be done during the nighttime."
 - Faculty Question: Question regarding losing faculty members. Cihtlalli detailed a response from Dr. Mitchell, Provost, "We do lose a few faculty members each year, and we begin immediately to start searches to replace them. With few exceptions we are successful but searches take time. While we advertise, collect applications, and interview, we hire temporary faculty or adjuncts to tie us over. This year we have lost more than we normally do and for a variety of reasons. Very few of them claim to be unhappy with TAMIU or with living in Laredo but they frequently leave for personal reasons and for career opportunities. Every case is different and this year we're losing at least three faculty members for the Fall Semester because of health-related reasons unrelated to COVID.
